Every Friday Students may wear their JEANS and a non-offensive shirt for \$1.00 each (school fundraiser)

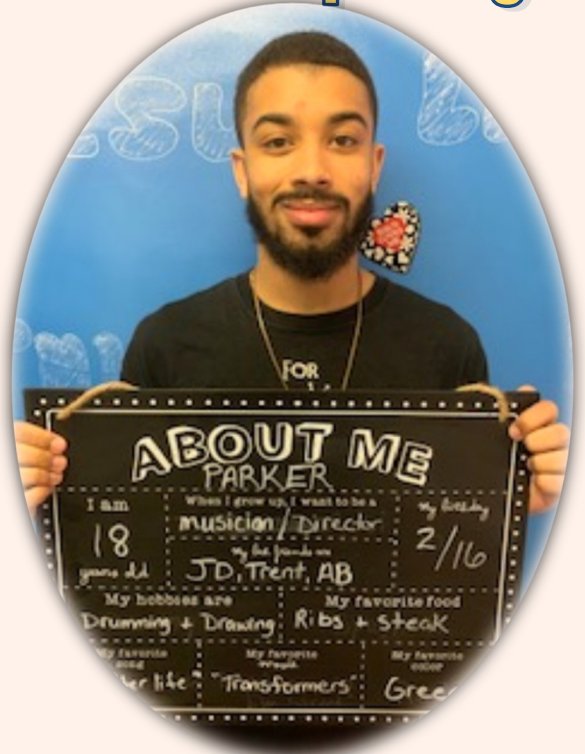
Appropriate jeans only-No holes Or places that resemble holes.
